NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

Summer Bridge: The Summer Bridge program is a full 10-week intensive program which fast-tracks the first year studios (ARCH 171 + 172) and drawing classes (ARCH 121 + 122). Students should expect to be in class up to 4 full days per week. Those who successfully complete the summer bridge would join the 2nd year cohort in his/her major the following fall.

Portfolios: Portfolios are *not* required for admission into the Architecture or Interior Design majors. We do, however, encourage you to submit samples of your creative work if they are available. If you choose to submit work samples, please bring copies of them with you when you submit your application.

Admission: Each Director will be reviewing applications as they are submitted regarding decision for entry into the Architecture or Interior Design major. Upon receipt of your application, you will be contacted to schedule an in-person meeting with the Director of Architecture or Interior Design as part of the application process. Each Director will formally notify you by email of his decision. If you are accepted, you will also be informed of the term of entry (Summer or Fall). Summer or Fall admission largely depends on the current cohort numbers and available seats. Upon acceptance, your major will officially change and you may set up an advising appointment with the college advisor to discuss specifics of your academic plan.

You will need to confirm admission acceptance, via email, within one week of notification.
