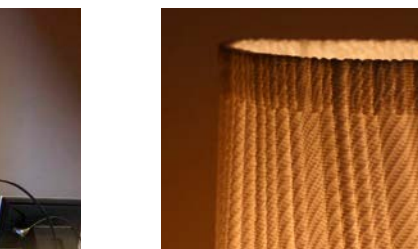
February 18

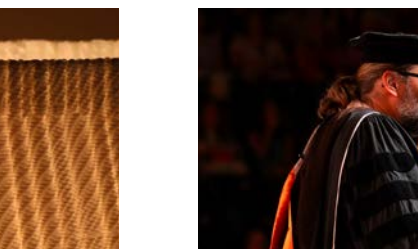
March 17

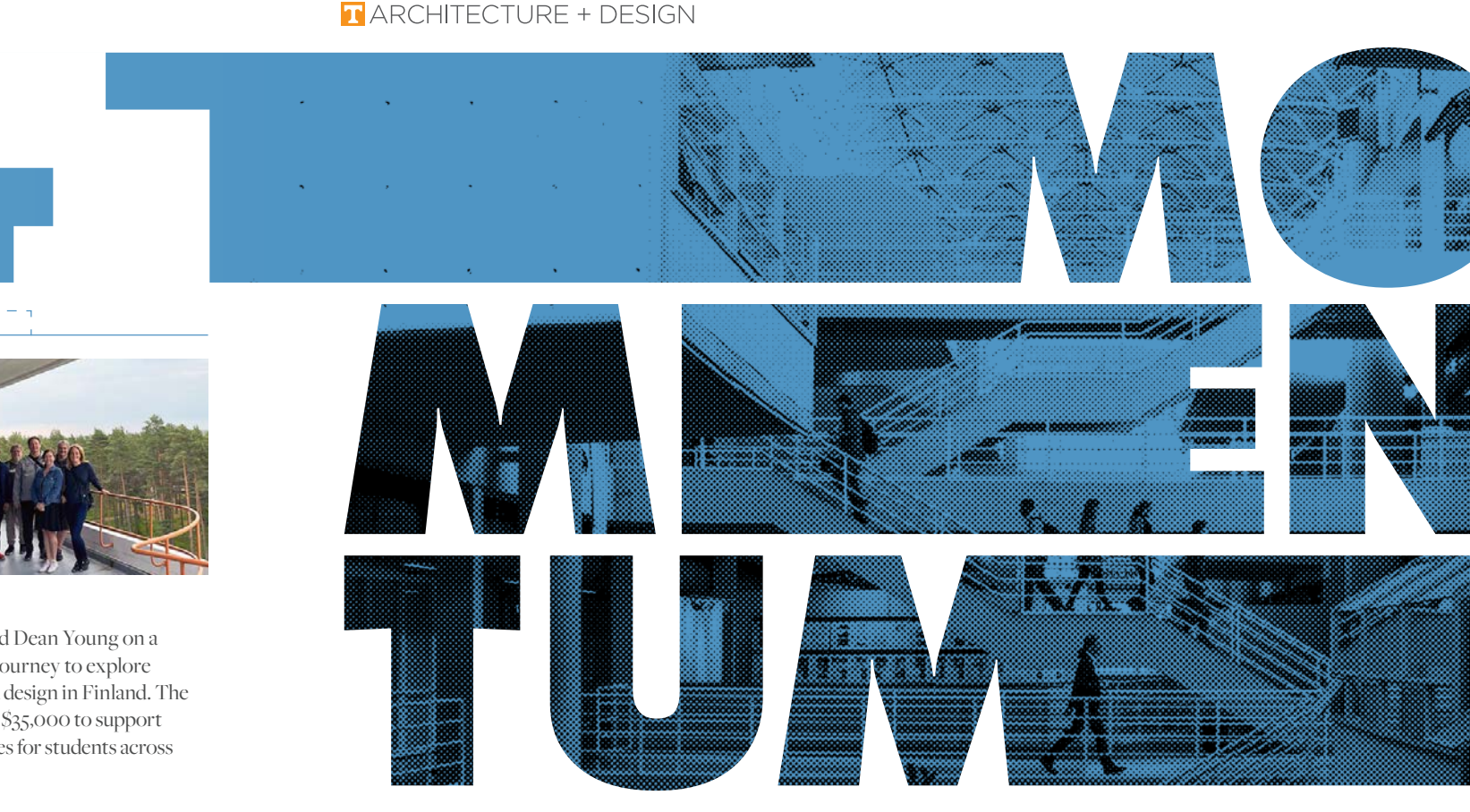
May 19
