#### **Creative Work/ Research Focus**

My research-creative work investigates architectural artifacts, infrastructures, and alterations that result from interaction between anthropogenic (human) actions, terrestrial systems (climatic, geomorphic, hydric-water, biotic, ecologic). The work is positioned in a neutral ground that recognizes that the relationships between human and co-resident actions, environments, places, and landscapes are complex and mutually influential. This intellectual stance allows me the flexibility to adopt and explore ethical and intellectual positions inflected toward select systems, design professionals, actors in a landscape, or to strive to attain the position of a neutral observer. Corollary to research described above is a search for effective methods to communicate and comment on the temporal expression, evolution and change of actions, processes, and narratives as described in archival records.

While this research is firmly centered in the architectural discipline, it requires adaption of content from allied cultural, scientific, and technical disciplines and a broad range of interdisciplinary collaborations to address aesthetic, phenomenal, theoretical, and applied design/planning applications of these themes. Scales of exploration include architectural project site, buildings, and detail, as well urban, neighborhood, region, and watershed.

My career trajectory of research, teaching, and travel has provided opportunity to explore these themes in a broad range of urbanized, rural, and wild locations on earth. At present, I work with hydrologic infrastructure landscapes with a strong focus on Tennessee Valley Authority projects constructed in the upper watershed (eastern) including the Norris Dam and its surrounding land reservation.
