## NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

**\*Summer Transfer:** The Summer Transfer program is a full 10-week, 11 CH intensive program which fast-tracks the first year studios (ARCH 171 + 172) and drawing classes (ARCH 121 + 122). Students should expect to be in class up to 3 full days per week. Those who successfully complete the summer program will join the 2nd year cohort in his/her major the following fall.

**\*\*Fall Transfer:** Architecture and Interior Architecture transfers can opt to start the program in the fall if unavailable for summer transfer or summer seats are limited.

**Portfolios:** Portfolios are not required for admission into the Architecture or Interior Architecture majors. We do, however, encourage you to submit samples of your creative work if they are available. If you choose to submit work samples, please attach copies of them with you when you submit your application.

**Admission:** Each Director will be reviewing applications regarding decision for entry into the Architecture or Interior Architecture major. For Architecture applicants, an in-person meeting with the Director of Architecture will be scheduled for April. Each Director will formally notify you by email of his/her decision. If you are accepted, you will also be informed of the term of entry (Summer or Fall). Summer or Fall admission largely depends on the current cohort numbers and available seats. Upon acceptance, you may set up an advising appointment with the college advisor to discuss the specifics of your academic plan and your major will officially change.

**You will need to confirm admission acceptance, via email, within one week of notification.**
